Should the application be approved, the tenant acknowledges and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The tenant accepts full responsibility as a pet owner to:
 - a. Maintain a high standard of cleanliness and sanitation in the unit at all times, cleaning and disposing of any animal waste on a regular basis.

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- b. Maintain a high standard of preventative health care (e.g. flea and worm treatment).
- c. Ensure the pet is registered in accordance with local council by-laws.
- 2. Any pet/s other than the pet specified on this application form must be first requested by the tenant in writing and via a separate *Pet Application Form* giving full details and then be approved in writing by Common Ground Queensland PRIOR to the pet/s being allowed onto the premises. Pet approval may be subject to specific criteria and must be complied with. Approval is NOT guaranteed.
- 3. The tenant shall be liable for any damage or injury whatsoever caused by the pet to the unit regardless of their approval status.
- 4. The tenant accepts full responsibility and indemnifies Common Ground Queensland for any claims by or injuries to third parties or their unit caused by, or as a result of actions by their pet regardless of their approval status.
- 5. The tenant agrees to arrange for Flea Fumigation (for Dogs & Cats) or Lice Control Treatment (for Birds) at the end of the tenancy or at a time during the tenancy as required or requested by Common Ground Queensland to be carried out be a Company complying with Australian Standards.
- 6. The tenant agrees to keep the pet tethered/contained and under control at all times in the foyer, lifts, corridors and outdoor communal areas. Pets are not permitted in internal communal areas unless in transit.
- 7. The tenant will ensure that responsible care is taken of the pet. This includes ensuring that the pet:
 - a. Is provided with fresh water and a diet to maintain full health and vigour.
 - b. Is provided with an appropriate environment including shelter, sufficient space, proper facilities and a comfortable resting area.
 - c. Receives prompt veterinary attention if it becomes unwell or injured.
 - d. Is well-treated and is not subjected to physical and mental suffering.
- 8. The tenant understands Common Ground Queensland may withdraw a pet-related approval at any time if these Terms and Conditions or the General Tenancy Agreement relating to the pet are breached.
